In order to keep peace and harmony in the Gurdwara Sahib the Sewadar Committee humbly requests all members of *sangat* to abide by the following code of conducts in premises of Sikh Society of Dayton. As per provisions of the constitution of the society, the committee can take appropriate actions in consultations with the *sangat* against a member who failed to abide by the following codes of conduct.

- Do not make unreasonable noise or an offensively coarse utterance, gossip, gesture, or display or communicating unwarranted and grossly abusive language to any member/members of the *sangat*.
- Don't insult, taunt, or challenge another, under circumstances in which that conduct is likely to provoke a violent response from the other member/members.
- Do not create a condition that is physically offensive to member/members or that presents a risk of physical harm to member/members or property.
- Do not engage in fighting, in threatening harm to other member/members of the *sangat* or property, or in violent or turbulent behavior.
- Take off your shoes and cover your head at all times in the service hall and the langar hall
- Shorts and saggy trousers are not allowed in the Gurdwara Sahib premises.
- Consumption of non-vegetarian foods, drugs, alcohols and smoking cigarettes in and around Gurdwara Sahib Premises are strictly forbidden.
